NAVY HOSPITAL 'SANJIVANI' DECLARED BEST IN KOCHI

Indian Naval Hospital Ship (INHS) Sanjivani has been declared the best hospital for 2011 by Cochin Clinical Society (CCS), a professional body of senior medical professionals in the city. CCS has all the major hospitals in the city as its members.

INHS Sanjivani commissioned in March 1958, caters to the naval community and ex-service men in the region. The hospital has 333 beds for in-patients and 16 departments including sub-specialties. The hospital also has in its premises the Ex Servicemen contributory health scheme (ECHS) polyclinic which was started in 2004. The medical teams from Sanjivani has been participating in disaster relief efforts across the country and abroad. Sanjivani medical team was the first foreign medical team to set foot in Sri Lanka after the Tsunami of 2004.

INHS Sanjivani is presently headed by Surgeon Commodore Girish Gupta, a renowned pediatrician.
