NAVY MEN TO EXPLORE HIMALAYAS ON MOTORCYCLE

A motor cycle expedition to Himalayas was flagged off from Southern Naval Command, Kochi on 10 Jun 11 by Commodore V R Kandru, Director, Naval Institute of Aeronautical Technology (NIAT). The five member team led by Commander E David will pass through Delhi, Jalandhar, Jammu, Srinagar, Kargil and Ladakh to the Siachen Base Camp and return via Manali, Chandigarh. The aim of the expedition is to foster the spirit of adventure as well as spread awareness about the Navy to the people of Himalayas. The team will traverse a change of altitude from sea level to 20,000 ft during the trip. This endeavour of the Navy is being supported by Indian Oil Corporation by way of providing fuel and lubricants during the entire trip.
