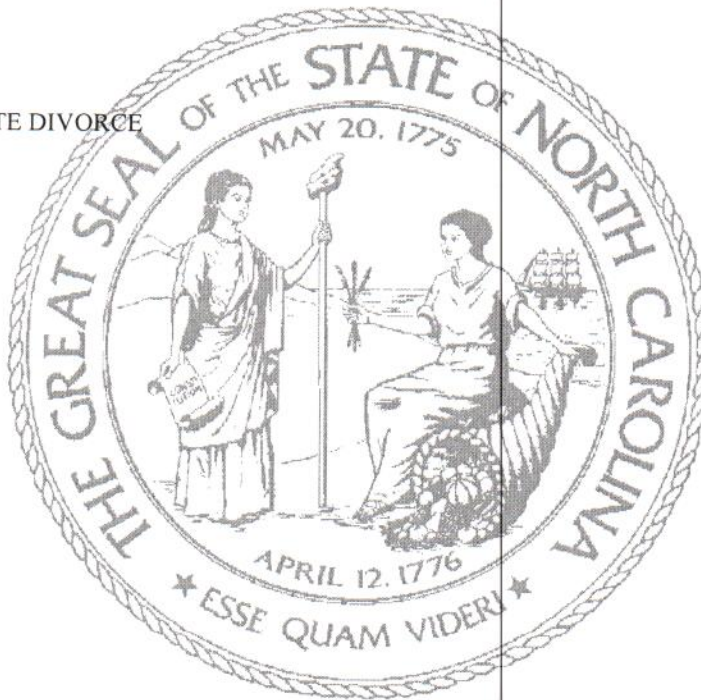



**JUDGMENT OF ABSOLUTE DIVORCE**

SALLY DIANE JOHN,

THIS CAUSE COMING TO BE HEARD, and being heard before the undersigned Judge presiding at the Civil Session of the General Court of Justice, District Court Division of Mecklenburg County; and it appearing to the Court that a Summons and Complaint for absolute divorce were served on the Defendant;

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Court that the Defendant has failed to file an Answer and that the time for filing such an Answer has expired, the Court makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. That, at the time of the filing of this action, 09-CVD-7282, Plaintiff was a resident of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, and at that time, that the Plaintiff has been a resident of the state of North Carolina for more than six (6) months prior to the filing of this action. Defendant is currently a resident of Sussex County, New Jersey.

2. That at the time of the filing of this action, 09-CVD-7282, the Defendant was a resident of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina. Defendant is currently a resident of Lancaster County, South Carolina.

3. That the Plaintiff and Defendant were lawfully married to each other on or about July 13, 1970, and lived together as husband and wife until on or about January 4, 2009, when they separated with the intent to remain separate and apart.

4. That since the date of separation, Plaintiff and Defendant have continued to live separate and apart from each other and at no time have they resumed the marital relationship which formerly existed between them.

5. That the parties have no minor children.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


1. The Court has jurisdiction of the parties to this action and the subject matter.
2. The Plaintiff is entitled to an absolute divorce from the Defendant pursuant to N.C.G.S. 50-6.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

1. That the Plaintiff, Thomas Edward John Jr., be and hereby is granted an absolute divorce from the Defendant, Sally Diane John, and the marriage heretofore existing between the Plaintiff and the Defendant be and hereby wholly dissolved.

2. That the costs of this action be taxed against the Plaintiff.
