crew have put a reef in foresail & kept below as it is
pretty wet on deck.

After we get out of harbours I get pretty sick
cannot face anything to eat.

Anchor at 11.30 am. go ashore & find that Mr
Luscombe has kept lunch back for us. Do justice to
it.

Get my gear on board & the rest of the stuff safely
stowed away.

Saturday 31.1.20

Get on board & make an early start for Mauboury.
Send N W breeze but it is a dead heat to
the island. The most of the way Tide favourable
for a couple of hours then it turns against us
make very slow progress. The island looks
very pretty as we approach. The big
groves of graceful Coconut Palm stand
up dark & green against the green tinged
red black & grey of the rocky hills.
Ancher & go ashore about 3 pm. Warmly
welcomed by Miss Dore.

After one cup of afternoon tea we go for a
walk to the Post Teachers place & give
Mr Menais my letter of permission from
Protector of Aborigines. Afterward go for
a walk across the island & then to the
top of small hill to get a view of the surrounding
reefs which now show up clearly as it is low water.

Sunday 1. 2. 20

Had a bit of a walk round. Only
Barned shouldered Doves, Eucalyptus
Warblers & Scrubbirds to be seen.

The island is very hilly rocky & barren
mostly covered with a low straggled heath
with small patches of Cotton tree & others
in small gullies on the hill sides.

One in the evening of the day writing
1 of Herald crew all with pens.

Monday 2. 2. 20

2 of the Donald crew are down with fever. Mr Bone could not get anyone to take their place today, so we could not go on to Gailoi. Short sharp rain squalls all the morning.

After lunch I got my gun ashore & went for a walk over the island. Along the beach a few nodules were seen. Curlew, Whimbrel Green herons, Golden plover Large sand Dotted. Little Grebe & a number of Grey & White wing Herons.

Amongst the Coconut palms Sea birds were plentiful. Several White winged wood Swallows seen flying high overhead. In the grass several small flocks of Finches noted. In a lane along a track through the hills. A couple of Brown backed Herons seen & 3 Lesser white Pigeon seen & a Eggon

Tailed Quakers heard calling. From the top
of a hill a view of the whole island could
be obtained. The hills are very rugged & steep
& there is very little flat country.

The timber is sparse & stunted. Patches of
vine covered low scrub about the hills &
gullies.

Tuesday 3. 2. 20.

Mrs Done down with fever
All the Herald crew & half the village
down. Mr Minnis & boys also down with the fever
Mr Minnis Government superintendent
invited me to stay at his place.

Said that he would send me on to Caribai
in one of the island boats.

village down. Cannot get a crew to
take a boat to Caribai.

Two Miramis were killed, both were seen.

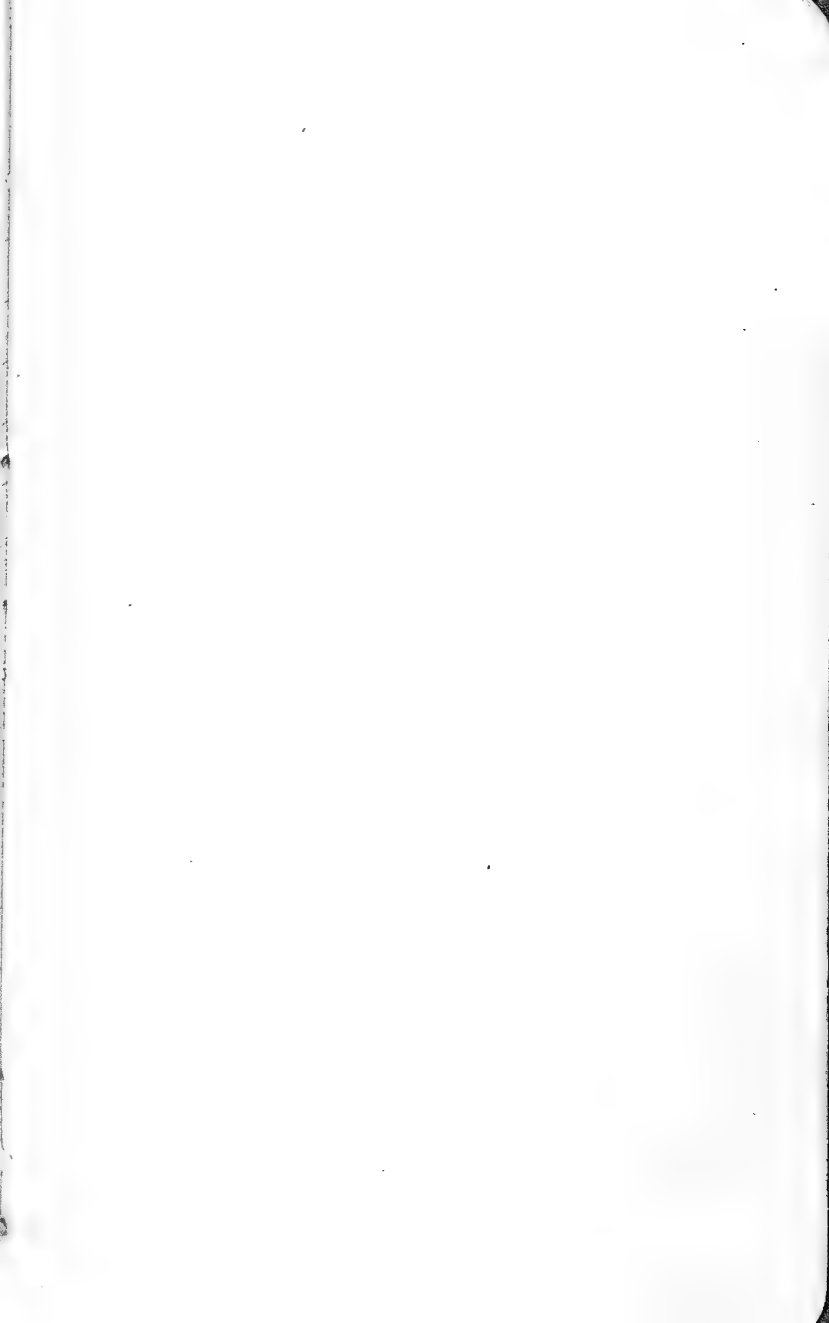

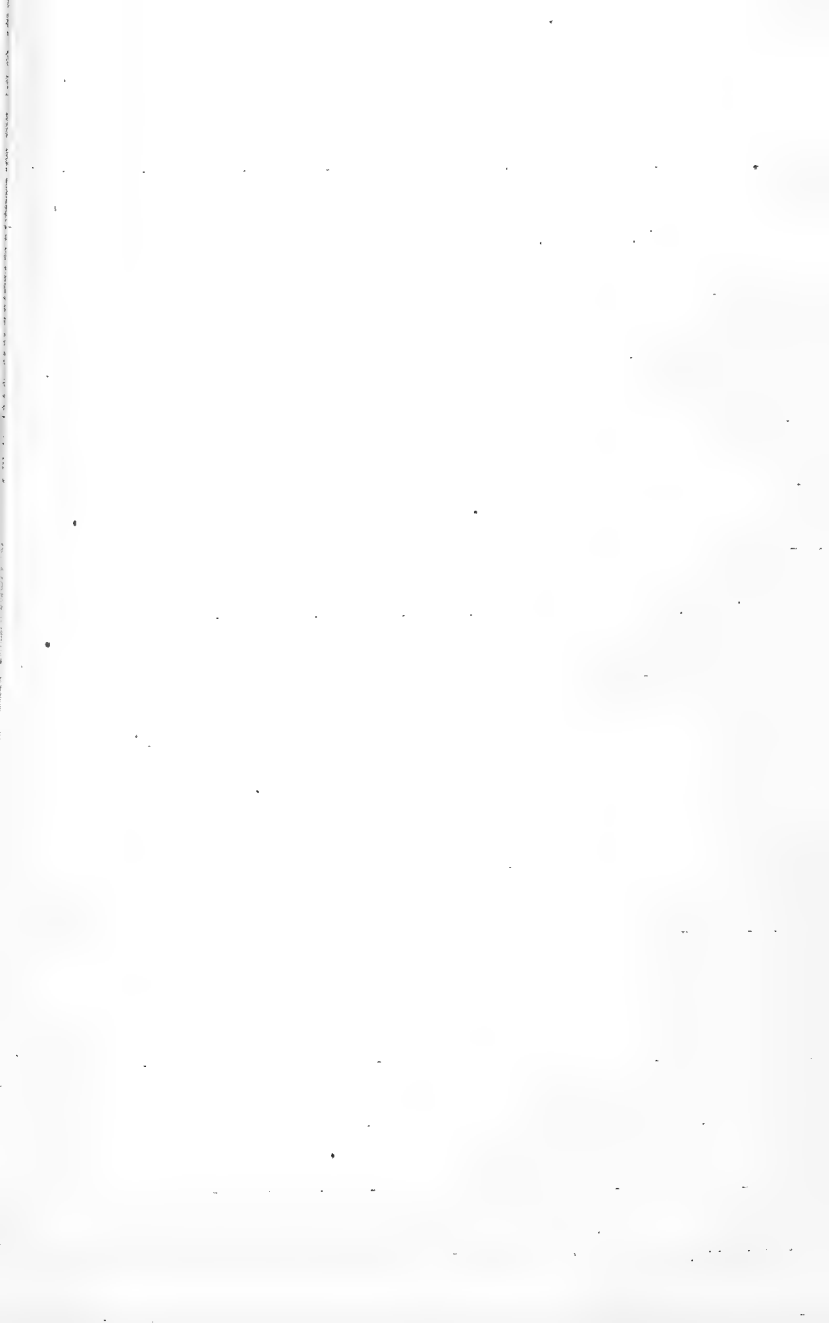
