It makes me angry  
that people are willing to  
accept what's given to  
them without questioning  
it or trying to improve it.  
Companies sell  
substandard goods at  
outrageous prices, and  
people buy them anyway.

perspective than their  
parents'. The public votes  
for the lesser of two evils,  
never realizing that there  
are other options.

I'm angry about  
the cost of my college, The  
Kansas City Arts Institute.  
It costs \$36,000 per year  
and I have no idea where it  
all goes. We have to buy  
all of our own materials,  
and there are also almost  
no tools made available to  
us by the school, so we  
mostly have to buy our  
own tools too. And I doubt  
that the teachers are being  
overpaid because my  
writing workshop teacher  
is living on food stamps.

It pisses me off  
that police can get away  
with anything. Some of  
them sell weapons, deal  
crack, and drive under the  
influence, but nobody  
cares. Any cop involved  
with police brutality  
should not only never be  
able to be a police officer  
again but should be  
arrested for assault. People  
defend those cops and say  
those "criminals" deserve  
to be beat up, but the  
criminals are the ones  
violating human rights.

It makes me angry  
that all high schoolers have  
to wake up around six by  
law. Its not blatantly stated  
in the law, but it is illegal  
to miss school, and school  
starts too damn early.  
Plenty of research has  
shown the importance of  
getting enough sleep, and  
it's just not reasonable to  
expect high schoolers to be  
not just in bed, but asleep  
by ten. This is completely  
unreasonable and a prime  
example of legal stupidity.

I'm angry about  
the legal age of adults. I  
am more responsible, more  
intelligent, and more  
capable than many legal  
adults I know, even though  
I am only sixteen. I am a

enough intelligence to  
figure out a way to do  
these things, even while  
causing a fraction of the  
damage to the environment  
that we cause now, and  
even spending less time  
working, but that we  
clearly can't get our shit  
together.
