## Going South

(going north! just reverse the directions starting in downtown portland!)

Van → white rock

\$5.00 3 zone canadian break bus 351 352, or 354

South to white rock. if on 351 or 354, get off at white rock centre and onto C54. if on 352, get off at 148th/oxford st and north bluff rd. walk south on oxford to buena vista ave or marine drive and get on C52. going left down marine drive. use your pass and get off on the last stop on white rock & blaine

Marine (stevie or stevens)

towards the sea there is a footbridge across from Stevye. take it, walk the path then walk along beach rd. there are little paths from beach rd to the train tracks. you can either follow beach rd to Hwy 99 to customs or walk the tracks to a sloped path up a cliff to a green park to customs. after customs walk to the park east of the peace arch, through the parking lot to 2nd, then walk south to D st and turn right until you see a wta bus stop

blaine & bellingham \$0.75 american take 70X to downtown bellingham stn. bellingham + mt vernon \$2.00 take 80X from station to skagit station mt. vernon + everett 2 choices! \$2.00 70X 70X skagit bus to everett station

everett island transit 411C to stanwood ride and step &

transfer to island transit 412 to everett station (free!) everett + seattle \$2.50 transfer the 510 or 513 to sound transit bus to a transfer point for the 594, 592. recommend 5th & jackson then walking to 4th ave S and walking south to a stop

seattle + tukwila get off at SR 512 part 2 ride and get on 592 or 594 with your transfer & get off at SR 512 p/r

tacoma + olympia \$1 get on the 603 or 603A to olympia station then another \$1 on bus 12, 13 or 68 to tukwater square

olympia + longview \$1 get on the CAP rural transit bus - off end then get a transfer & get on another CAP bus to Salmon creek fair \$1 get on another CAP bus to Salmon creek fair to delta park/vanport station! the yellow light rail choices! \$3 take the express 105, 134 to pdx or!

\$1.35 to downtown Vancouver (any bus that goes there) then get a transfer & get on the 41, 44, or 47 longview + vancouver \$1 go north to go north to vancouver, bc from pdx on 105 or 134 will take you downtown.



When traveling with public transit, it is a good idea to double check the days and times of bus operations. the times in this are accurate as of december 20th 2008, so just double check before your grand adventure! the websites are listed above, in transit, feel free to ask the driver questions before boarding like "does this bus go to \_\_\_\_\_?" how much is the fare? "can you let me know when we get to \_\_\_\_\_ stop?" etc. wta and intercity drivers can be particularly nice and translink and cap can be a little rough around the edges, in my own experience. there is also an alternative route around the peninsula. presently it is possible to go portland to vancouver, bc in a day but one has to stop somewhere heading south. ☺
