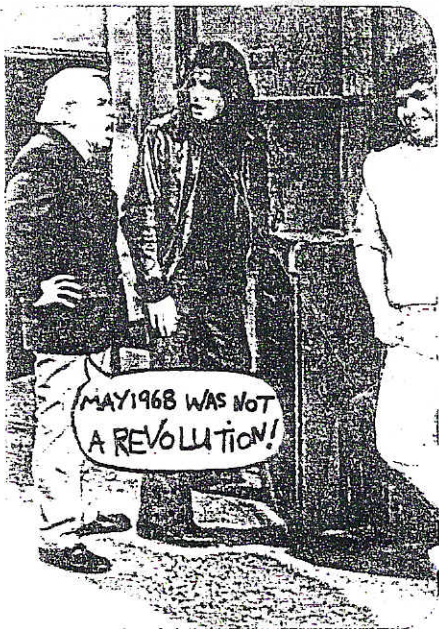


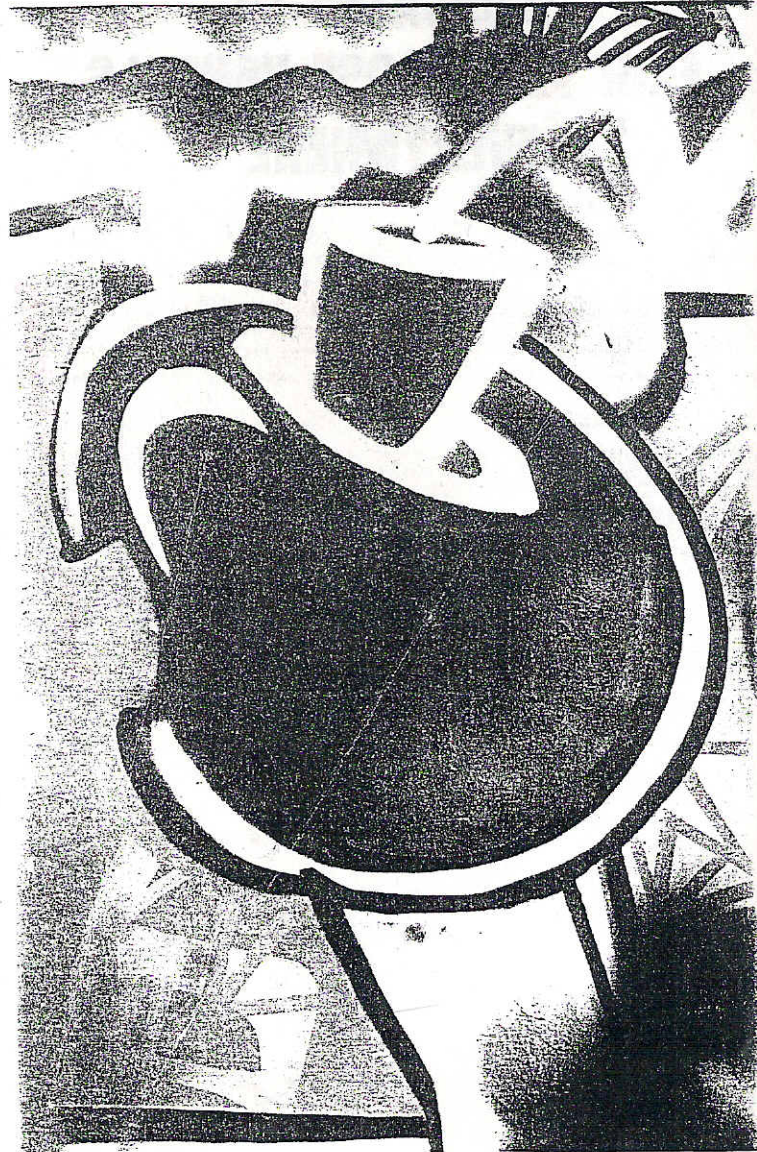
**YOU TOO CAN BE A GRAFFITI
